When the end of the night beckons, make your stay presidential! Originally called the Grant Hotel, Ulysses Suites offers historic, luxurious self-contained accomodations in a fitting tribute to our 18th President.

If the bed and breakfast experience is more your speed, what better place to rest for the night than one of America's best B&Bs? This gem was voted the #1 B&B in the USA and #2 in the World by TripAdvisor in 2019 for a reason. For nearly 100 years, the four-story Jail Hill Inn served as Galena's jailhouse. Today, it's decorated with ornate gas fireplaces, features bubble massage tubs, and includes a wonderful reception of wine and cheese on arrival.

Those who prefer a quaint stay in the countryside will want to consider The Inn at Irish Hollow, which is located on 500 acres of picturesque, rolling hills and has been called "deliciously rustic" by the New York Times.

If you're fantasizing about more pampering in the morning, check into Eagle Ridge Resort and Spa. In addition to traditional massage, facial and nail services, the spa offers an extended luxury body-wrap treatment - with this to look forward to, you can expect sweet dreams indeed.
